One of the responses from the recent Northminster Deep Dives offered this insight, that "in 20 years, we would be celebrated for embodying just what a Neighborhood Church should be!" I am grateful for this vision work, because without setting our sights on the importance of the future, we can fall into the dormancy of becoming irrelevant.

Here are some ways that we have been living into our vision as a Neighborhood Church:

We hosted a substantial neighborhood meeting in early February for the purpose of discussing the safety and validity of the shelter. While the meeting did not result in unanimity, it held respect and appreciation for all of those present. Most importantly, it created a civic space for generative, face to face dialogue. While hosting space for local hobby groups and recovery groups, we are also seeking to host space for groups that have been marginalized by securing the work of the SHARE shelter and opening our space to a New Worshipping Community.

Marginalization takes on many forms. SHARE opens the door to those that have been marginalized from financial security, while the New Worshipping Community makes space for those that have been marginalized by religious power. We need to make space for this sort of growth in our facility, and the session has been working hard to make this happen. On a fun note, we are working to create more opportunities for neighborhood dialogue and interaction through our coming Upcycling Opportunity and our Repair and Restore Initiative. More on this in the coming weeks, but it highlights the work of the Outreach Team and findings of the Deep Dive. We just want more places to be a support to our Neighborhood, and we are finding them!
